Why are we having challenges getting international exchanges? Below is FFI's Analysis of 2013 Exchange Requests. The statistics in the table below reflect an analysis of the 2013 exchange requests. The data was compiled from club requests submitted via the 2013 online Planning Request Form or by correspondence and telephone conversations with Friendship Force International (FFI) staff.

Listed here are the countries in which Friendship Force International has a presence, the number of clubs in that country, the number of weeks of hosting available, and the number of requests to visit each country. You will notice that some very population destinations, for example, Austria, has only two clubs and only two opportunities for exchange. Other countries like the US have many weeks available but may have already been visited several times by the same club. This creates challenges in matching clubs. Because of this we have been working on strategies to change this. I'll be happy to listen to your ideas.

The countries marked "*special*" are countries in which special programs allow us to have a virtually unlimited number of exchanges in a given year. In some cases there may be no club in that country; instead FFI has a partner organization with which we arrange programs.
