Current plan of focus is as follows:

1. Program and Speaking Engagements - Obtain program or speaking engagements at service clubs and other organizations. The purpose is to make more persons aware of Friendship Force and attract new members.

Progress: Already have one set up at a PEO group in April. My goal is to prepare a presentation (probably PowerPoint) while in Florida this winter, but first need to find out what Victor already has prepared.
