Kosovo Initiative

At the last board Meeting a discussion was held on the proposal to help establish a FF Club in Kosovo. Steve Williams and Laura Thomas presented the work their committee has been doing. They have enlisted the support of Friendship Force International, Sister States/Cities in Des Moines (which includes individuals associated with FF Des Moines), and General Gashi, Kosovo Consul General.

The proposal is to send representatives to explore the establishment of a FF Club in Kosovo. Two members of the IC/CR club, Lori Thomas and Connie Williams will be traveling with Sister Cities in early May. A member of FF International will be following up with a trip in June. The board decided to help defray the cost of our members.

The board sees this as a worthy effort to help spread the ideas and philosophies of Friendship Force. Friendship Force International is excited that this would add a European club (in demand) and establish precedent for future FFI ventures and the Sister States Program.

The hope is that the next step would be to possibly extend our 2020 Journey to Budapest, Hungary with a visit to Kosovo.





Update for the Brazil Journey.

A group of 16 Ambassadors will participate in the CR-IC Journey to Brazil. We have four participants from our Club and 12 from across the US and Canada.

The Journey begins on June 26 with a five-night homestay in Ribeirão Preto Portuguese for "Black Stream." This is one of the most important cities in São Paulo state, with about 600,000 inhabitants, health center, several universities, hospitals, and clinics

The Iguassu Falls excursion will include a three-night hotel stay near the Falls entrance on the Brazil side. During our stay we will visit the Falls on both the Brazil and Argentina sides, the local Bird Park and Rafain Dinner Show.

There will be a five-night homestay with the Salvador Bahia Club. Known as the "melting pot" of Brazil, we will learn about the city's "Bahian" culture, history of the Portuguese settlers, and the African slave trade (which was banned in 1835). The Journey concludes on July 9 in Salvador.

As our Regional Support Manager says, we can definitely expect to have a lot of fun!
