Tour of Kendrick Forest Products Iowa's largest sawmill, Tuesday July 13th at 11:30

Here is some information about out upcoming tour.

Kendrick Forest Products includes the sawmill, mulch operation, and kiln dried lumber operation. For the second part of your tour the guide will direct you to our North facility, just five blocks north, where you'll tour our sister companies and their operations; Forever Cabinets by Kendrick, Kendrick Home and Shimlee, and The Markket. Tours will end at our North facility where guests will have time to browse The Markket, our retail destination. All companies on the tour are a division of the Kendrick, Inc. suite of family businesses.

The tour cost is \$5. Please wear comfortable, closed toe shoes. Eye and Hearing protection will be provided. The terrain is rough and uneven, call for handicapped assistance if needed. There are stairs inside the mill. Following the tour, we will meet at the Edgewood Golf Course for lunch and order off the menu.

Drive up Hwy 13 to Hwy 3 and turn right at the Edgewood Sign, continue into Edgewood passing the Woods Edge Golf Course to Washington Street (west side of Community Saving Bank Building), turn right and go straight to the Kendrick parking Lot at 601 S. Washington St.


family run hotel, the Cottage House Inn, https://www.cottagehouseinn.com/. Rooms are \$100 a night with one or two queens and will be held until August 7.


blooming. We ended the day with a meal at La Casa De Pancho in Maquoketa.
