Silage Salad from our Amish Meal

1 can corn drained 1/2 c. White vinegar
1 can green beans drained 1/3 c. Vegetable oil
1 can peas drained 1/2 c. Sugar
4-5 stalks celery chopped 1 tsp. Salt
1 large red or green pepper chopped 1/4 tsp. Black pepper

1 medium to large red onion chopped 1 tsp. Celery seed

Mix all together and refrigerate over night.


