
ternational. He also facilitated communication and exchange of ideas between clubs. We thank Dale for representing us so well.

Transportation

You can fly to Dallas-Ft. Worth Airport or Love Field. Or you can choose to drive (13 hours driving time). American Airline has a non-stop flight. I found a ticket for \$590. United and Delta also have flights that connect in various cities. I did not check all options so you may be able to find better rates or use frequent flyer miles. If arriving by airplane, plan to land by 2 pm September 21. Based on Dallas traffic, this will enable your hosts to meet you and comfortably make the welcome dinner.

COVID Policy

The Dallas club's policy requires:

- All participants on an inbound journey must be fully vaccinated against
 Covid 19 at current CDC levels
- All hosts and family in their house, must also be fully vaccinated against Covid 19 at current CDC levels.
- All members, guests or other persons who attend or participate in any event that is part of an inbound journey must be vaccinated against Covid 19 at current CDC standards or have a negative Covid 19 test taken within the prior 3 days.
- · Masks may be required at all group meetings, events and travel according to the current CDC guidelines, except when seated to eat. Hosts may determine the extent of mask use in their homes by themselves and their guests.
