## **Emails from Ukraine by Margaret & Ron Nelson**

As soon as the war started in Ukraine I began to wonder how Andrii and Misha were doing. We hosted them for Open World in November of 2018. I first had to dig through my files to see if I could find emails for them and after some futile attempts, I was able to find addresses and attempt to contact them. Within a week or two I got



responses from both. What has been surprising to me is their gratitude for keeping in touch and not forgetting them! My most recent email is from Andrii. His relatives and friends who are on the war front are, fortunately, healthy and "alive". He has been in a small town in the Kyiv region conducting training for IDP's (internal refugees) in the field of education. He says "it is nice to see people who, although they lost their homes, did not lose faith in themselves and humanity."

Misha is also engaged in very important reforms for the country but is feeling that he may be called for duty at any time. He comments that it is "difficult for many to understand why Russia can still attack hospitals, shopping centers, schools and universities with missiles. Our infrastructure is simply being demolished---sadly!"

They close their emails with the memories and the friendships they made

with us and thank us for the military support we are giving to them. Misha goes on to say we have made him feel like he has "another big family. It's very precious. Thank you so much." These are touching words from people who are going through a horrific war. And that is what friendship is all about!




If you are still interested in going to New Zealand/Australia and March/early April 2023 works for you, please let me know.
