FFI Announces Individual Journeys






view!



The next day was completely different as we started testing wine early in the morning at the d'Arenberg Cube. As unusual as the outside, so was the inside including the men's restroom.






We also got to drive south along the coast and stopped for lunch and a view of the Southern Ocean. The next stop is Antarctica!
