These are fluid guidelines due to Pandemic fluidity.

1. Follow CDC and local recommendations and requirements (see links below)

Example: At this writing vaccinations are not mandated, but strongly recommended.

2. Negotiate with those we are visiting and who are visiting us to facilitate participants feeling safer.

Example: If guests feel most comfortable staying in a vaccinated home, we will work to provide this.

3. Testing before and during journeys will be negotiated with journey participants

4. Provide sanitary accommodations to guests like liquid hand soap and hand sanitizer in your home, along with paper towels for hand drying in a multi person bathroom. Wear masks and social distance as the situation dictates.

5. Remember that some of our members are immunosuppressed. With this in mind, even though members are vaccinated, at certain times or situations extra precautions with masking and distancing would be appreciated.
