The American Leadership Experience, known as ALEX, will again send participants our way.

Twelve young adults from Ukraine will be hosted by Friendship Force of Cedar Rapids - Iowa City from October 26 through November 2, 2023.

These participants applied in 2019 for the 2020 high school year, but Covid and the Russian invasion of Ukraine sidelined their lives. Like the Albanian students we hosted in 2022, they are given the opportunity to spend several days in



Washington, DC, then a week in Cedar Rapids - Iowa City. As not all participants are currently living in Ukraine, they will first group and spend a week in Warsaw, Poland, before coming to the US.

If you would like to meet these ALEX participants, join us at the Coralville Library on Sunday, October 29 at 1pm. Dr. Russell Ganim will present a program about the International Students at the University of Iowa. We hope some of those students will join us that day as well.

Orchestra Iowa will present Symphonic Sci-Fi at the Paramount Theatre on Saturday, October 28. Our group of ALEX students from Ukraine will be in attendance. 
We will be entertaining our friends all over Eastern Iowa from Dubuque to Kalona to Iowa City and Cedar Rapids.

General Meeting August 20

The plight of refugees and what can be done to aid them was the topic for a general meeting at the Coralville Public Library on August 20. Amir Hadzic, Mt. Mercy University's award-winning men's soccer coach, spoke about fleeing his home in Bosnia during the civil war there, his life in a refugee camp, and his eventual resettlement in Iowa. Amy Weismann, assistant director of the University of Iowa's Center for Human Rights, told of her former work as a humanitarian aid worker in a refugee camp and her current legal advocacy for refugees. She also shared information about what citizens can do now to help refugees.
