FFI Fees for 2026

In 2027, FFI celebrates it's 50th year. Friendship Force International asks for your support in a renewal initiative we'll explain and discuss at our annual meeting.

The mission of Friendship Force International is to promote global understanding and goodwill by bringing people from different cultures together through citizen diplomacy and homestay programs. While the mission of citizen diplomacy remains the primary focus, economic and political issues have made it difficult for FFI to operate on the journey fee driven budget now in place. Covid also played into this, as no income came from journeys at that time. The past two years have had a deficit budget and reserves have been used to meet expenditures. During that time, club members were paying \$30 for their membership fee to FFI. Out of the \$45 Cedar Rapids-Iowa City club charged per year, \$30 was sent to International with \$15 remaining with our local club.

The FFI Board of Directors and FFI Advisory Board have been working with Jeremi, Allison, Taryn, Debbie and Dana (the 5 full time staff) for the past year and a half to revisit and revamp FFI structure. We wish to survive our 50th anniversary and beyond, promote global participation and continue to promote our message of citizen diplomacy at a time when it's truly needed. To do this, our members need to provide more income so that FFI will not be running in the red. The new fee for each club member will now be \$100. This will now be paid directly to FFI. Cedar Rapids-Iowa City club will continue to charge the \$15 per year per member.



Birmingham in February 22-27, 2026



We have 2-4 openings for this journey. Birmingham, AL is located at the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains. Birmingham was born out of the iron and steel industry. The city is well known for its role in the Civil Rights



movement. Modern Birmingham is a much different place brimming with entertainment, the arts, outdoor recrea-

tion and world class cuisine. Several local chefs have received or have been

nominated for national awards, even the James Beard Foundation Award. It is home to art galleries, golf courses, antique shops, and trendy malls. There are many family green spaces such as Railroad Park. With a mild climate

employer with the University of Ala-


lunch. Hopefully we will be able to schedule more of these fun outings to other interesting parts of our own back yard. Look for information in future newsletters.
