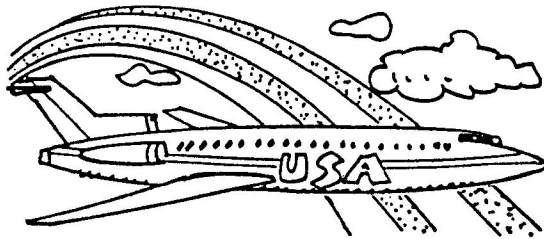
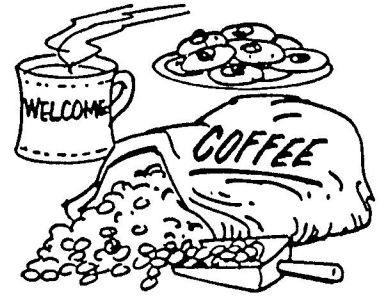


# WELCOME TO A NEW YEAR

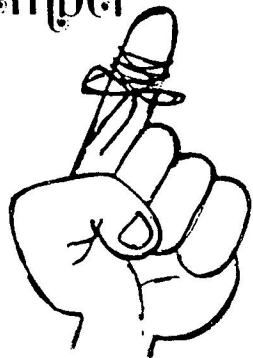
