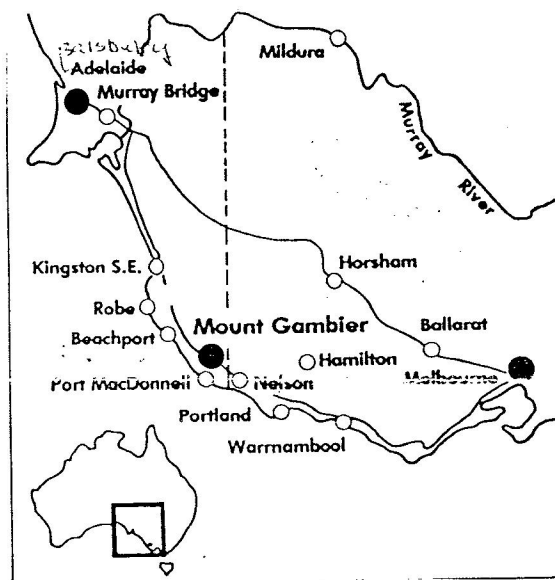
AUSTRALIA EXCHANGE

After the exchange a possible optional tour to New Zealand is in the planning stage. More information later!

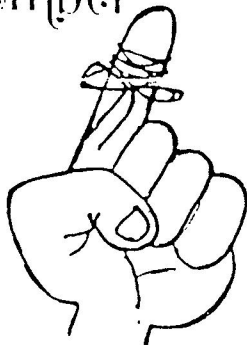
I've talked to Ken McEachern (the exchange director in Mt. Gambier) and he wanted me to tell you how much they are looking forward to our visit.
