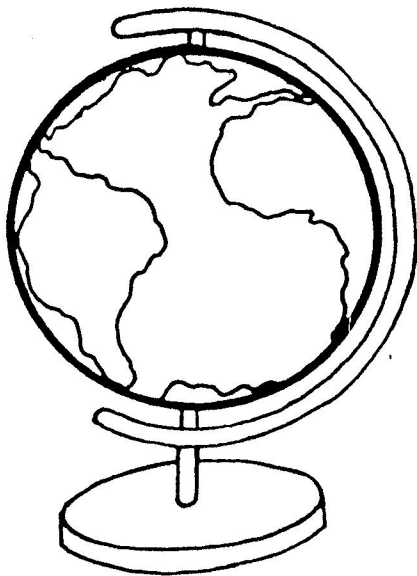


A WORLD OF FRIENDS IS A WORLD OF PEACE

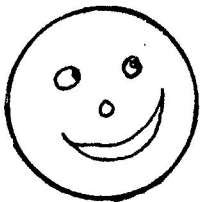
